

### Grammar

#### English to French Equivalents — Time

English words do not always have a direct equivalent in French.

Look at the following expressions:

- et demie half past (translates to, 'and half')
- et quart = quarter past(translates to, 'and quarter')
- moins le quart quarter to (translates to, 'less the quarter')

It is often the case in a different language that you cannot translate word for word; you have to learn some expressions by heart in order to be able to express yourself correctly in French.
