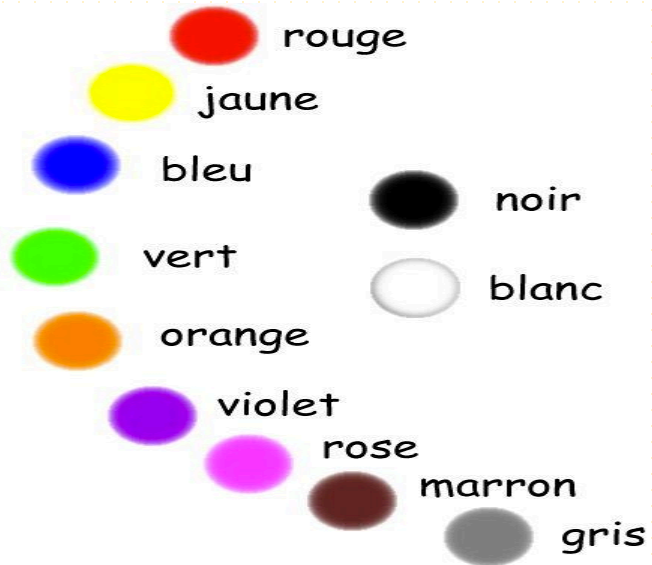

Grammar

English to French Equivalents – Time

English words do not always have a direct equivalent in French.

Look at the following expressions:

- *et demie* – half past
(translates to, 'and half')

- *et quart* = quarter past
(translates to, 'and quarter')

- *moins le quart* – quarter to (translates to, 'less the quarter')

It is often the case in a different language that you cannot translate word for word; you have to learn some expressions by heart in order to be able to express yourself correctly in French.
