



Occupation: British painter

Born: 14th May 1727 Suffolk

Died: 2nd August 1788 London

Blue Boy Mr and Mrs William Hallelt

Style/Period: Renaissance/Romanticism

Fascinating Facts

He sometimes painted with brushes on sticks 1.8 metres. This put hm at the same distance from the subject and canvas. His favourite thing to paint was landscapes, but people would only pay for portraits. He painted Mr and Mrs Andres on their estate and found a way to paint landscape and get paid for the portrait. He painted a portrait of Johann Christian Bach.
