Our Topic this half term is Transport.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Through our topic this half term, we will continue to learn how to share with our friends and take turns. By playing with toy vehicles together and engaging in pretend play scenarios, like driving a bus or being a passenger on a train, children will learn to negotiate roles and share resources, fostering positive social skills. You could help your child by engaging in pretend play scenarios at home.

Communication, Language and Literacy

As part of our topic, we be sharing both fiction and non - fiction books about transport - this will include the oral story '**The Train Ride**'. We will learn lots of actions and use picture cues to help us retell the story. We will be using lots of pictures to help us talk about different types of vehicles. We will also be singing new songs and rhymes about transport.

Mathematics

As part of our topic on transport, this half term we will be using language such as big and little; tall and short; and taller and shorter to describe and compare size. Our focus on number will continue through our daily counting activities as well as counting, sorting and matching cars, buses and trains. You could help your child by talking about all the different transport you see on the walk to and from nursery.
