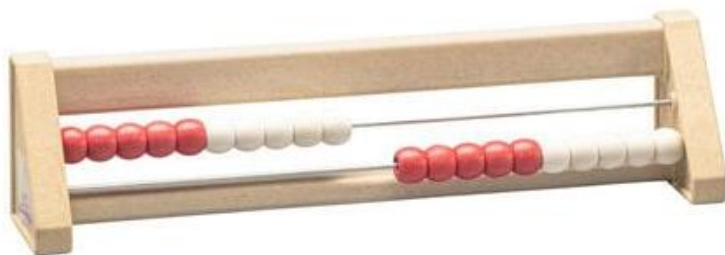
Sponsored Walk

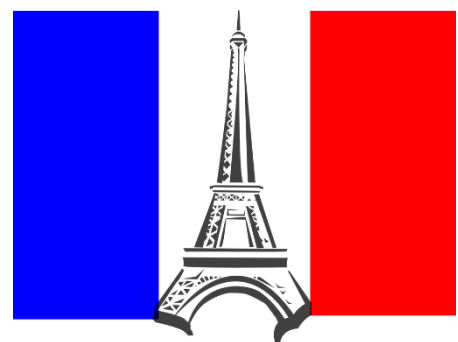


A huge thank you once again for your kindness and support – we can't wait to start using our new abacuses in September!
