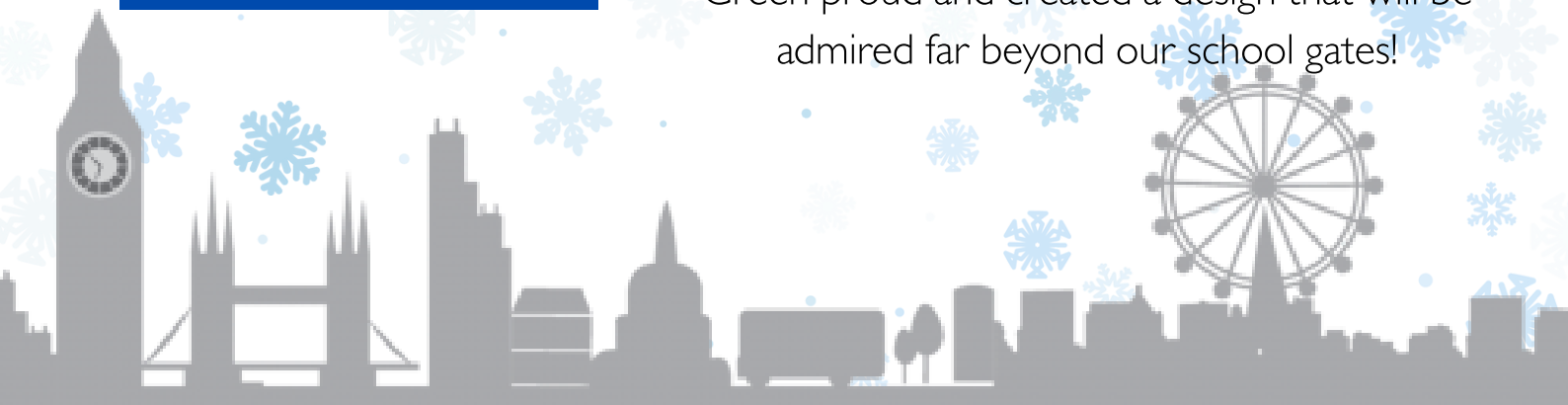
Ramisa Wins Prestigious Christmas Card Competition!

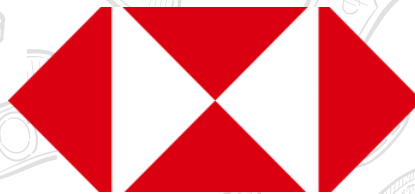


Learning About Money with HSBC
