Literacy

We will be sharing lots of fiction and non-fiction books about ourselves which will include asking questions about the books we have read. We will be encouraging children to make up their own stories by looking at pictures and through role play.

You can help your child by reading them a story every day. Please remember to come and join our DEAR sessions to share a story with Mrs Page and the children. Then choose a book to read at home with your child. Look out for the poster with details of dates and times it will be in Nursery window.

Mathematics

Your child will take part in daily counting activities in their key worker group. As part of our topic we will be learning about numbers which are important to us; such as our age, house number and members of our family. We will be talking about and using shapes to make our homes.

You can help your child by looking at numbers and shapes in the environment. Can they count their eyes, ears, nose and fingers? Can they follow the video below?
